

## FAQ's for Grant Application Instructions:

Q. What do you mean by Planning?

- A. Think about your project from start to finish, or from finish to start. The idea of reverse engineering can be helpful. What tools will you need? How many people are needed? Where will the materials come from? Who has a van or truck you could borrow for transport? Can you collaborate with other camps or projects?

Q. What is an itemized line budget?

- A. A line budget is like a **grocery bill**. Each item is listed with its cost, and then all the item's costs are added together for a total estimated project cost.

Q. How is that different from a list of the stuff I'll need?

- A. The stuff you need is like your **grocery list**. Fruits, veggies, eggs, coffee, etc. It is too general and not itemized or broken down into individual costs.

Q. Can I get a grant for fire art and fuel?

- A. All fire art must be approved by our Fire Arts Safety Team (F.A.S.T.) before receiving a grant. If your project requires fuel and has been approved by FAST, you may qualify for our Fire Arts Fuel Fund. This fund usually comes directly from the event's budget.  
You can apply for a grant for the construction materials to create fire art.

Q. Who qualifies for our Travel Aid Fund?

- A. Our Travel Aid Fund was created to help remove the cost of travel as a barrier for Art Projects and Theme Camps that wish to attend Kindle Arts events on Vancouver Island.

- May include partial/full fuel reimbursement with receipts, for travel over 150 km not exceeding \$0.45/km, or up to \$200.00 round trip, whichever is most economical.
- Limited to vehicle and trailer costs up to 40 feet.
- Grants can cover up to \$300 Maximum reimbursement for ferry costs/return trip.
- Overall gas and/or ferry reimbursement that meet the above criteria is capped at \$500 maximum, and only with receipts & mileage documented and presented.
- This fund is for Art and/or Theme Camp transport, individuals must pay their own way.

If travelling from farther away than the Pacific Northwest, please contact us and we can discuss more options if funds are available.

*Example: Travelling from Hope to Otherworld is 254 Km + ferry with a 20' trailer could qualify.*

Standard vehicle rates for BC Ferries with a 20' trailer:

\$57.50 (up to 20 feet) + \$6.50 per foot after x 20' = \$130 each way.

\$57.50 + \$130 = \$187.50 one way = \$375 round trip.
